




# A light FOR THE FUTURE



#### By leaving a Gift in your Will, or by honouring the memory of a loved one, you are supporting your family of faith in the Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay.

The Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay was first established in 1986. In the years since, it has provided the Sacraments, pastoral care, faith formation and a sense of community to more than 218,000 Catholic Residents across 26 parishes and the Korean Catholic Chaplaincy, 44 schools and CatholicCare services in Northern Sydney, the Northern Beaches and the Central Coast.

Many of our parishes and pastoral initiatives exist due to Gifts left by previous custodians of our Faith who, in leaving a Gift in their Will, have ensured that we, and future generations, benefit from their generosity.



## Your **LEGACY**

### Frequently Asked Questions

#### What is a Gift in Will?

A Will is a legal document that details how you would like your assets distributed after your death. A Gift in your Will allows you to take comfort in knowing that what is important to you - your family, your friends and your faith - is provided for now and into the future.

#### How do I leave a Gift in my Will?

A Gift in your Will is a very personal decision and a solicitor can help you with the options available to you. You can choose to leave a specific sum of money or a percentage of your estate, a non-cash asset, such as property, paintings or shares, or the residual amount of your estate after you have made provision for your family and friends. We strongly recommend that you involve your family in your decision, letting them know that a Gift to the Church is important to you and that you will provide for your family first.

#### How is the money used?

You may choose to support either your **Parish** or the **Broken Bay Pastoral Trust**, or both, with a Gift in your Will.

- A Gift to your Parish supports the ongoing maintenance and operational needs of your local family of faith.
- A Gift to the Broken Bay Pastoral Trust will support the mission of the Catholic Church in the wider community, including seminarians, youth activities, faith formation. marriage support and social justice groups.

#### Do I have to share the details of my Will?

Not at all, but letting us know allows us to recognise your generosity in your lifetime.

#### How do I make a Gift In Memory?

Please fill out the form on the back page and we will contact you to discuss meaningful options for your Gift.

#### **Suggested wording to a Parish**

I declare that the receipt for the same signed by the Bishop of the Diocese, or other designated officer, shall be sufficient discharge to my Executors and Trustees.

### **Suggested wording for the Broken Bay Pastoral Trust**

I give to the Trustees of the Roman Catholic Church for the Broken Bay Pastoral Trust (ABN 51 674 844 081) in the State of New South Wales for its general purposes, the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_ percent of my estate or the property at \_\_\_\_\_\_ (or other specific items), free of all duties, taxes and other deductions of whatever kind.

I declare that the receipt for the same signed by the Bishop of the Diocese, or other designated officer, shall be sufficient discharge to my Executors and Trustees.

The above wording is intended as a guide and we strongly recommend you seek advice from a solicitor. You may wish to contact the Law Society of NSW for their Solicitor Referral Service.
